Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had a wonderful Holy Week in School and we have been so impressed with the KS2 Holy Week tableau each afternoon. Each year group has told the story of Holy Week with great reverence.

#### Attendance:

A huge well done to all of our pupils who received a 100% attendance badge today – these children attended school every day between January and today. There is another opportunity to achieve a 100% badge for the summer term if children attend every day between April and July. All children who achieve an overall of 97% attendance and above at the end of the school year are awarded with a medal.

## Summer School Uniform:

After the Easter break, children may return to school in the summer uniform. This consists of a white polo (if children remain wearing a shirt, they must wear their tie) or yellow checked summer dress. All children may wear white socks or tights. The polo shirts do not need to have the school logo on, but please do not buy polos with frilly sleeves or collars – they must be a simple plan white polo. 


