Rationale for French: to foster a love of learning French and hopefully in the future other modern foreign languages. To equip the children with strong reading, writing, speaking and listening skills in French.
At Springhill, French is taught according to the Language Angels scheme of work.
We teach it this way because: everybody starts the academic year revising French phonetics which is vital to the children's progression in each of the four strands of learning – reading, writing, speaking and listening. The degree of difficulty in each year group's learning is well pitched and is designed to ensure there is good progress made.
It matches the national curriculum – how? We foster pupils' curiosity and deepen their understanding of where French is spoken in the world. We strive to ensure that the children can express their ideas and thoughts in French and that they can understand and respond to spoken French both in speech and in writing
We go beyond the curriculum here: as we have the children writing sentences in French by the end of year three.
