Springhill Catholic Primary School Uniform Policy

The school uniform is compulsory and is supported by all parents. Please ensure all items of school uniform are labelled. On page 3 of this document are visuals of the school uniform.

Winter Uniform:

The school winter uniform is worn from September through to the Easter Holidays.

Essential: Grey skirt, pinafore, trousers or shorts, white shirt and school tie.

Burgundy jumper or cardigan with the school logo.

Grey or burgundy tights and grey school socks are allowed. **Only in year 5 and 6** – girls may wear black tights (40 denier or above)

Black closed school shoes (no trainers, sandals or boots allowed).

School book bag in Year F-2.

Optional: burgundy parka or fleece with the school logo.

A coat is required for school. No denim jackets or colourful fleeces are allowed.

In Year 6, parents are given the opportunity to purchase a leavers hoodie. These may be worn at break and lunch times by the children but not in class. They will still require a school jumper to keep them warm.

Summer Uniform:

The summer uniform can be worn from after the Easter holidays through to July when the summer holidays begin.

Shirt and tie may be replaced with a white polo shirt (this can be a plain white polo or the polo with the school logo). Girls may wear a yellow and white checked dress.

Black closed school shoes (no trainers, sandals or boots allowed).

School book bag in Year F-2.

PE kit:

PE kit is needed all year round, on PE days, children will change into their kit at school. They then will finish the school day in their kit and go home in it so it can be washed and returned ready for every Monday.

Essential PE kit

Black shorts, gold t-shirt and black plimsolls.

Black tracksuit trousers may be worn in the winter for outdoor games.

No branded items allowed.

Black plimsoll shoes are needed for children In Year F, 1 and 2.

Black trainers are needed for children in Year 3-6.

Bags:

PE kit bags and book bags with the school logo.

As locker space is limited, FS, Year 1 and Year 2 are not to bring in backpack. They are only to use a bookbag. Year 3 – 6 may bring in a backpack.

Jewellery:

Should not be worn to school. If a child has pierced ears, then we permit the wearing of one pair of small, plain studs, even these can be dangerous in a playground situation and must be removed or taped over for PE lessons.

Hats:

Suitable protective head gear for sunny weather or cold weather.

Hair:

Plain, narrow hair band, ribbon or scrunchie in the school colours. Designs shaved in hair or dyed hair are not suitable for school.

Any family experiencing difficulty in purchasing the school uniform should speak to the Head Teacher or the Home Link Worker.

Please make sure all uniform is named.

Special Educational Needs:

As our uniform is easy to wear, adaptations aren't generally required. In the rare event that an adaptation is required, this would need to be agreed by the SENDCo.

Springhill School Uniform

Winter uniform can be worn all year round and has to be worn from September through to Easter. No boots or black trainers are allowed. School shirts can be long or short sleeved and must be worn with the school tie. The school jumper and cardigan can be worn (no other alternatives). These can be purchased at Koolskools. The school tie can also be purchased from Koolskools. Socks must be grey and tights can be maroon or grey. Strictly no backpacks are allowed in FS, Year 1 or Year 2.
