### Sixth Sunday of Easter

### Gospel John 14:15-21—Keep my commandments

In this Gospel reading, Jesus is trying to prepare his disciples for what is coming next - his death on the cross and his rising again.

He tells them that if they love him, they must keep his commandments. Jesus asked us to love God and to love one another.

How do you show your love for others? How do others show their love for you?

It is often easy to show our love for those people who are close to us. We can be kind and generous to our friends, we can listen to our friends and family and they show their love for us by comforting us when we are upset, by looking after us and by comforting us.
