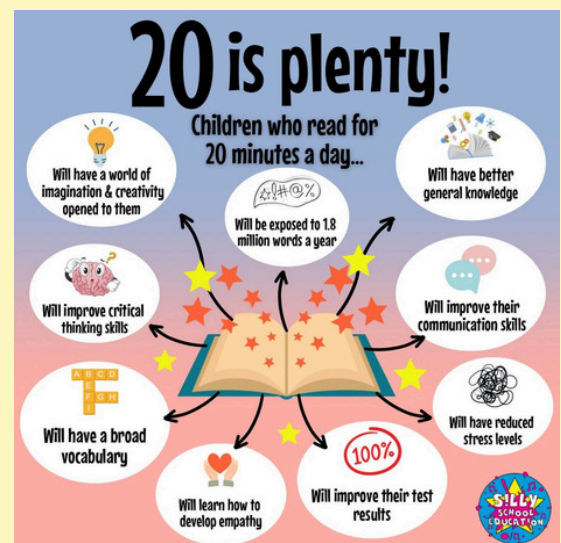

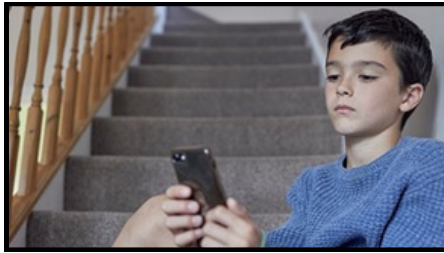

Online Safety:

Talking to Strangers Online



Children are often taught about stranger danger in the real world, but it is equally important to understand this in an online context.

Online, it can be difficult to know who you are really talking to. People may pretend to be someone else, including a child of a similar age, to gain trust. This can happen on social media, in games, or through messaging apps.

Children may be asked questions about their personal life, such as where they live, what school they attend, or who they live with. These questions might seem harmless, but sharing this information can put them at risk.

As a parent, it is important to explain that not everyone online is who they say they are. Encourage your child to only communicate with people they know in real life.

Remind them never to share personal information, photos, or videos with someone they do not know. It is also important they understand that they should never agree to meet someone they have only spoken to online.

Creating a safe space for your child to talk is key. Let them know they can always come to you if something doesn't feel right, and that they won't get into trouble for speaking up.

Sport News:

The school has been involved in a whole host of football friendlies over the past few weeks. The U11 boys' team played Townhill Park and Ludlow Junior in a mini tournament before they played a friendly match against Highfield C of E School along with the girls from the same year group, whilst the U10 girls' team played against Bassett Green Primary in a competitive friendly. The U11 girls also played against Ludlow Junior and Townhill Park in a similar mini tournament. The U11s travelled down to Waterlooville to play a friendly (girls and boys in separate matches) against Woodcroft Primary where the girls won and the boys lost. The girls' U9 team travelled to Bevois Town Primary and defeated their compatriots from that school.

The cricket season started recently as our U11 girls played a friendly against Ludlow Junior, gaining some valuable match practice before yesterday's city event where the two teams finished 3rd and 6th. Well played to all 16 cricketers, the majority of whom gave overarm bowling 'a go' which was fantastic.

On Monday of this week, ten year 2 children were invited to represent the school in a Football Festival at Staplewood (Saints' training campus). This was a truly inspiring treat for the children and they enjoyed every minute, playing matches against six other schools. Well done to all of you.

The U11 mixed basketball team represented the city in this week's County Finals, finishing a very creditable 8th out of seventeen schools. Having qualified for the latter stages of the competition after winning five of their eight group games, they pushed the eventual winners (Orchard Junior) all the way in their quarter final, only losing on 'free throws' (the equivalent of penalties in football). Well played to Quinn, Jacob, Alex, Myah, Inga and Lauren.
