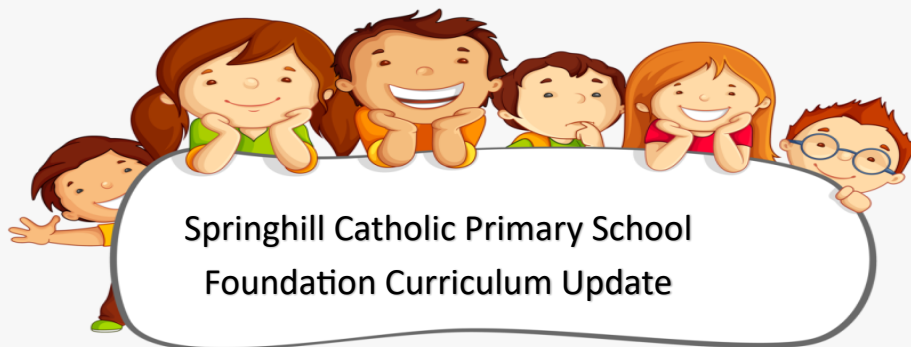

Dear parents and carers,

We hope you had a relaxing half term holidays. We are looking forward to a sunny Summer term filled with fun.

Our topic focuses on 'Under the Sea' this term. After that we will be exploring the topic of 'Space.' We will also be doing lots to prepare the children for Year 1 this term .

In RE, the children will be learning about Pentecost and how the Holy Spirit empowered the disciples and can empower us too.

In PSHE, we will be focusing on transitions and dealing with change and growing and up.

In phonics, the children we will be encouraged to 'speedy read' meaning they will be recognising words without sounding them out. Children will be recapping all of the sounds that they have learnt so far.

During handwriting, we will extend our sentence writing and encourage children to write more than one sentence with a capital letter, finger spaces and full stops. We will be writing our own versions of 'The Rainbow Fish' and 'Aliens Love Underpants' in Drawing Club.

In maths, we will be exploring number patterns including doubles, odds and evens and halves of numbers. We will be learning to recognise some coins and using them to recap our number bonds to 10.

In Understanding the World, we will focus on the story "The Rainbow Fish" and "Whatever Next" using the stories to extend our play and creativity.

We will continue to work on our garden and make sure our plants are well cared for.
