Sport News:

After the weather had been victorious over the recent weeks, it was great to see the children back playing sport and representing the school.

Well played to our U11 touch rugby team who represented the city in the recent County Finals where they finished a very creditable 11th.

The U11 girls' football team defeated Wordsworth Primary School whilst our U9 and U11 boys' teams both defeated Holy Family Catholic Primary this week in their respective football matches.

The annual Buzz Cup started recently where six schools compete for this football trophy. One win and one defeat for our U11 mixed team leaves us in 3rd place as we strive for a top two finish to contest the final.

Due to all the building work taking place on and near the athletics track, a new format was introduced this year for the annual city KS2 athletics event. Competing in teams of 8, two teams from Springhill joined twenty-two others in a Quadkids format where every child ran 75m and 600m, threw the vortex and took part in the standing long jump. Fantastic team efforts ensured that we finished 10th (Jemima, Grejs, Christabel, Caitlin, Joseph, Ikenna, Eddie and Dami) and 2nd (Harvey, Milan, Jacob, Lochlann, Mia, Myah, Tinaye and Inga), respectively.

Special mention goes to Tinaye, who finished 7th out of approximately one hundred girls, and Harvey, who won the boys' event out of a similar number of children. The latter team will now go to represent the city in the County Finals - well done to all sixteen athletes!

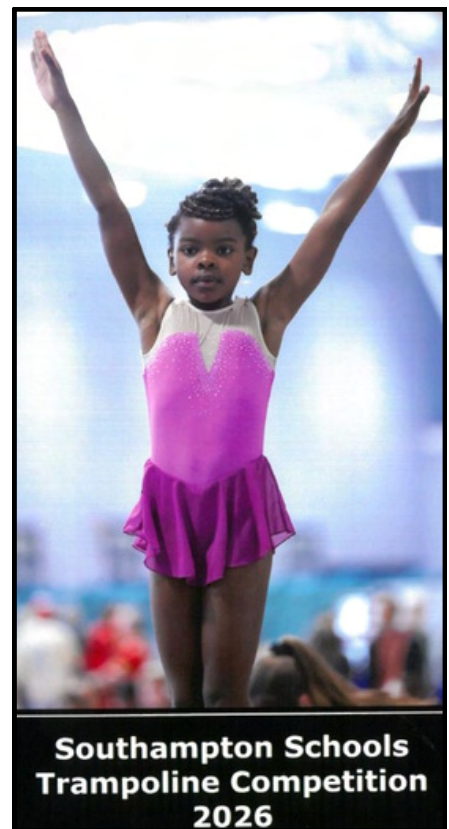


Celebrating Achievements:

Online Safety:

Fake News and Misinformation!

Children are growing up in a world where information is available instantly. However, not everything online is accurate or trustworthy.

Fake news and misinformation can spread quickly on social media and websites. This can include exaggerated stories, misleading headlines, or completely false information presented as fact.

Children may not always have the skills to question what they see, which can lead to confusion or misunderstanding.

As a parent, you can support your child by encouraging them to think critically. Ask questions such as: "Where did this information come from?" or "Does this seem reliable?"

You can also explore information together, comparing different sources and discussing how to spot trustworthy websites.

Teaching children that not everything online is true is an important part of digital literacy. These skills will help them make informed decisions and navigate the online world more safely.
