Online Safety:

Sharing Photos Online – Thinking Before Posting



Sharing photos online has become part of everyday life. However, it is important for children to understand the risks and responsibilities involved.

Once an image is shared online, it can be difficult to control where it goes or who sees it. Even if a post is deleted, copies may still exist.

Children may also feel pressure to share images to fit in with peers, without fully thinking about the consequences.

As a parent, it is helpful to talk about what is appropriate to share. Encourage your child to think before posting and to consider how they would feel if others shared the same image of them.

Remind them not to share personal information through photos, such as school uniforms, locations, or identifiable landmarks.

You can also model positive behaviour by being mindful of what you share online.

Helping children understand digital footprints will support them in making safer choices.
